TP provide an environment where boys are encouraged to push themselves and explore their talents in all phases of life on campus free from the pressures and distraction that are unavoidable in the context of a coed school. We teach boys and stand by them as they develop into men. We achieve this goal by prodding, praising, cajoling, and exhorting.



Every six weeks, each student receives an effort grade from the faculty. They consider all aspects of student work: academics, dorm life, athletics, extracurricular involvement, campus service, and more. Students are placed in Group 1 (highest) through Group 5 (lowest), depending on the commitment shown to a student's teachers, coaches, peers, and most important, to oneself.



Each student will have at least one year of music, theater, visual art or art history. Over a third of the school, are involved at any one time in the Visual Arts from 7th to 12th grade. Teachers with professional experience in their medium guide the students on projects in a step by step manner, providing both a classical artistic foundation and the freedom to explore. The studios and dark room are open in the afternoons, evenings, and on weekends with all the materials accessible for student to use. The Art Studios are places where every boy can develop the visual skills.



TP has always valued the important role athletics play in the development of each student. T-P believes that participation in sports teaches lessons that can be applied in life. Discipline, sacrifice, teamwork, friendships and memories of rivalries, league championship games and buzzer beaters will stay with our boys forever. 13 varsity teams, T-P's league competitors, all of which are in New England, include Avon, Kent, Hotchkiss, Loomis, Choate, Taft, Kingswood-Oxford and Westminster.
